Seniors turn in Friday, May 26 before your rehearsal

Everyone else turn in the last day of school, Tuesday, May 30 A block or after school

If you bring us your uniform pieces and parts at any other time we will tell you to wait until the appropriate time

Boys: Machine wash the coats, pants and red shirts. Hang dry all of it.

Girls: Red dresses: Cold water and woolite, hang dry. NO WASHING MACHINE, NO DRY CLEANING.

Girls: Make sure earrings have been turned in. \$10 if you don't have the earrings.

Boys: Dry clean black and white suits. Machine wash gold shirts, hang dry. Hand wash sparkly shirts, hang dry.

Boys: Turn in white shoes and black concert choir shoes

Boys: Turn in black ties

Girls: Dry clean velvet dresses. DO NOT machine wash!

Black Dresses: Cold and woolite, hang dry. NO WASHING MACHINE, NO DRY CLEANING.

Girls: Make sure your earrings have been turned in.

Boys: Machine wash the shirts, dry clean the black tuxedos (don't worry about dry cleaning the vests)

Boys: Hand in black ties and black shoes and the vest
